



Prayer Prompts for Overcoming Sin

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Acknowledge your sinful nature.	<i>For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Come before the throne and ask for forgiveness.	<i>If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Be willing to do what the Lord has called you to do.	<i>Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin. (James 4:17)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Take off the yoke of bondage and stand in the freedom of Christ.	<i>Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. (Galatians 5:1)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Remember that whatever you sow you will also reap.	<i>Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. (Galatians 6:7-9)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Pray that you can flee from youthful lusts.	<i>Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. (1 Timothy 2:22)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Trust that all things work together for good.	<i>And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Ask Yahweh to wash your sins as white as snow.	<i>Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. (Isaiah 1:18)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Pray for the strength to confess and forsake your sin.	<i>He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. (Proverbs 28:13)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Treasure up his word in your heart.	<i>Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. (Psalm 119:11)</i>
