from the 66 books of the Bible

**Haggai:** Help me to consider my ways (chapter 2:7).

**Zechariah:** I praise You, Yahweh, for Your holiness (chapter 14:20-21).

**Malachi:** Teach me to revere your name, Yahweh (chapter 4:2).

**Matthew:** May I shine my light before men and not hide it under a basket (chapter 5:14-15).

**Mark:** May my faith make me whole (chapter 5:25-34).

**Luke:** May I always run back to you, Yahweh (chapter 15:11-32).

**John:** May I willingly share the Gospel with others (chapter 3:15-17).

**Acts:** Yahweh, lead me wherever you call.

**Romans:** May I never be ashamed of the Gospel of Christ (chapter 1:16).

**I Corinthians:** May I focus on the things of the LORD (chapter 7:34).

**I Timothy:** May no man despise my youth (chapter 4:12).

**II Timothy:** May I finish my course with strength (chapter 4:7).

**Titus:** May I be a keeper at home (chapter 2:4-6).

**Philemon:** May the sharing of our faith be effective (verse 6).

**Hebrews:** Help me to fix my eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of my faith (12:2).

**James:** Help me to pray with faith and not doubt (chapter 1:6).
